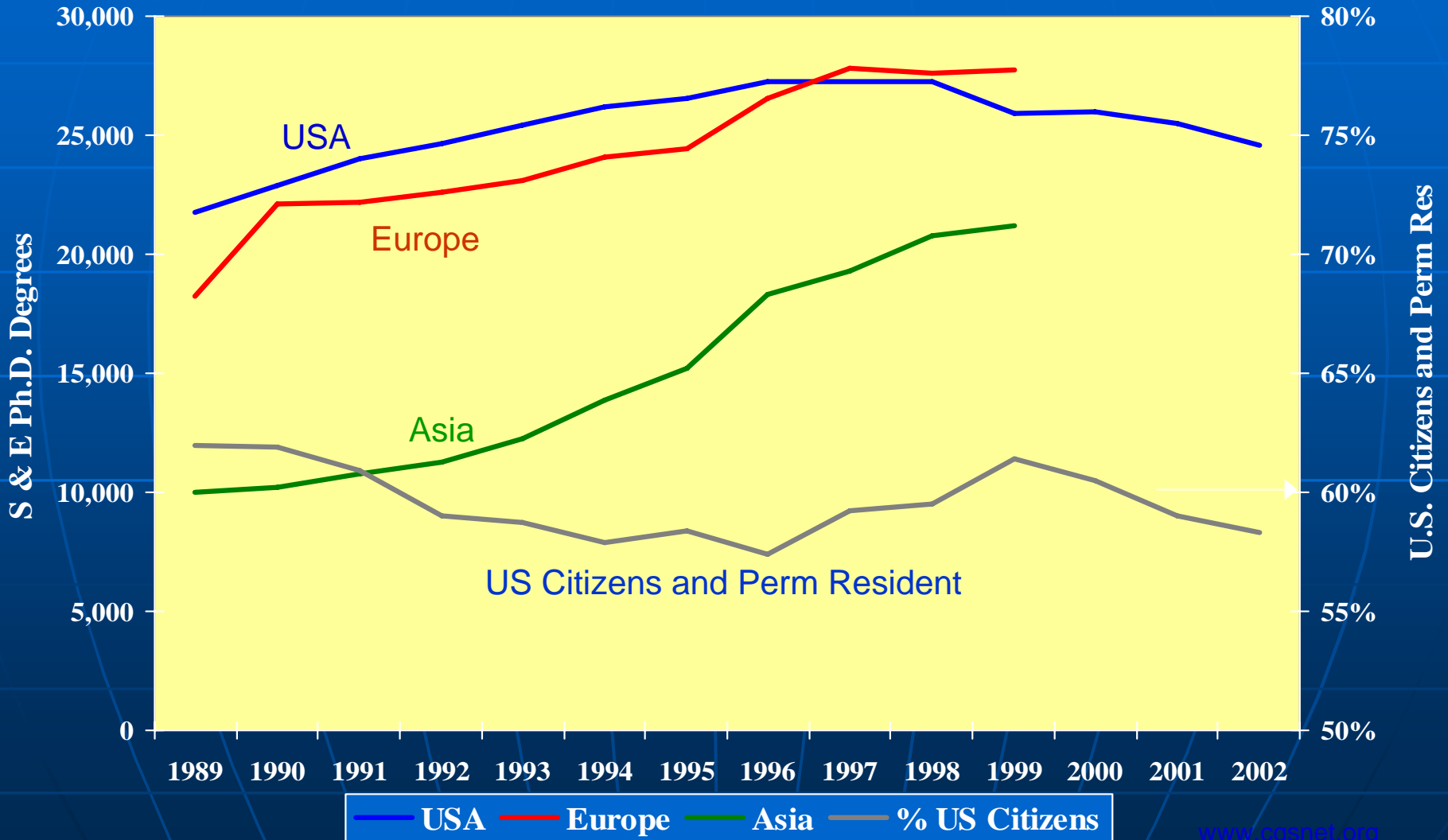

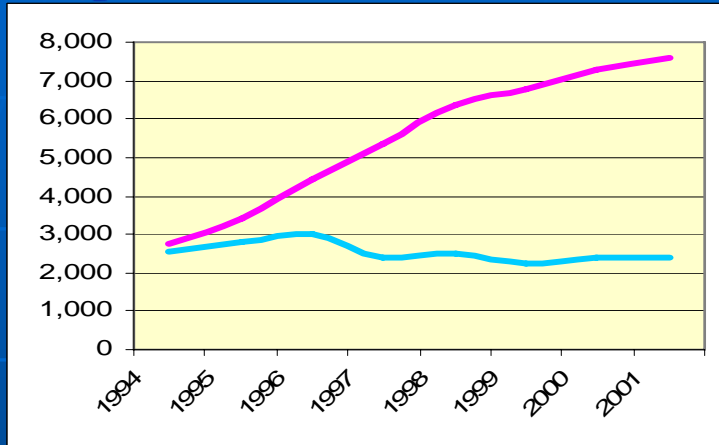

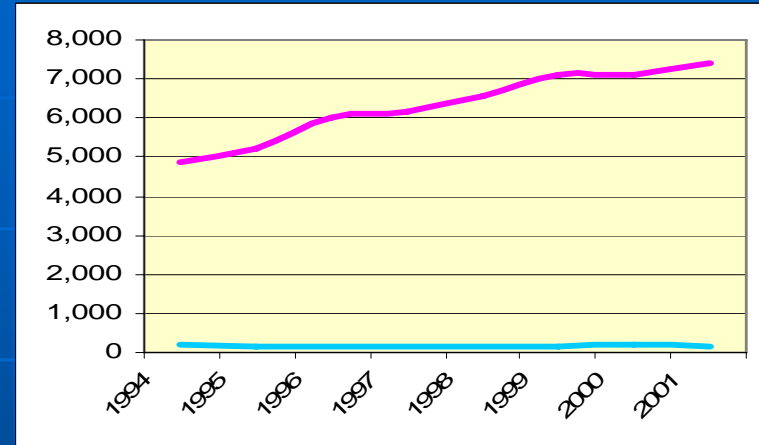


# Number of Ph.Ds in S&E earned in the US and at Home Institutions, 1994-2001

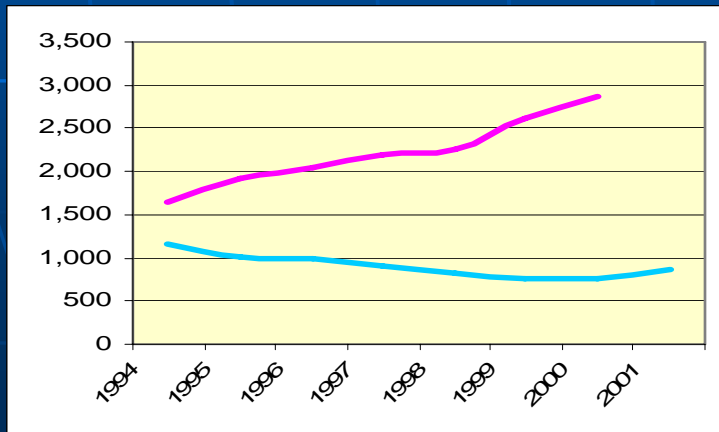

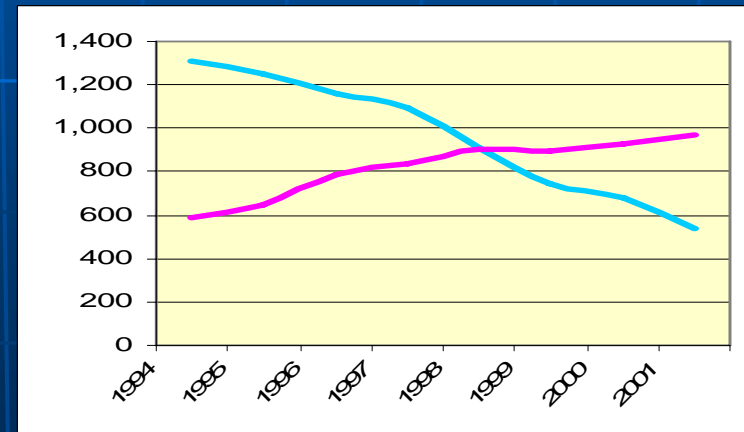
